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Refraction and Contact Lens Policy

The **refraction**, the test that determines your **eyeglass/contact lens** prescription, is usually **not covered** by most health insurance companies. Despite this, the refraction is often a necessary part of your eye examination. The refraction is the only way to determine your **best corrected vision**. This is a critical part of your eye examination, since a loss of best corrected vision may be the first sign of eye disease.

The charge for the non-covered refraction part of the eye examination is **\$75.00**, payable at the time of your visit.

For contact lens wearers, the refraction fee is \$100.00, which includes an evaluation of your contact lens fit as well as your eyeglass prescription.

All refraction fees collected at the time of your visit will be submitted to your insurance. If insurance covers the refraction portion of your examination, we will reimburse you for the refraction fee paid at the time of your visit.

If you do not need or want refraction at this visit, it will not be performed and no fee will be collected.
